GOVERNMENT URGES EMERGENCY MEASURES FOR TYPHOON AFTERMATH

[Text] The premier of the government has sent the following message to the comrades secretaries and chairmen of people's committees of the lowland and midland provinces of Bac Bo and Thanh Hoa Province, and the comrades ministers and leaders of central sectors:

Typhoon No 4 has landed in the coastal area between Quang Ninh and Haiphong and moved deep into the lowlands and midlands of Bac Bo; and it has turned into a low-pressure zone in the Hoa Binh mountain area, Son La. Thanks to good preventive measures, the damage caused by winds was not severe. However, the typhoon has triggered heavy and very heavy rains in a large area covering almost all of the lowland and midland pro-vinces of Bac Bo and Thanh Hoa Province.

At present, serious waterlogging is reported in the Bac Bo lowland provinces. The flash flood water level is rapidly rising in the rivers of the Thai Binh river system. Meanwhile, the water of the Red River has topped the emergency-2 level and is rising fast. A new typhoon has formed in the west Pacific and weather conditions still remain bad in Bac Bo. The situation concerning typhoons, waterlogging and floods in Bac Bo is thus very critical.

The premier of the government requests that the various ministries and the people's committees of the lowland and midland provinces of Bac Bo take the following emergency measures to control floods and waterlogging and to overcome the aftermath of winds and typhoons:

1. Employ all measures and deploy all forces, including the armed forces, to protect the dikes and control floods. Resolute efforts must be taken to firmly protect the various dike systems and dams, protect major projects and warehouses, and prevent and control flash floods in the mountainous regions.

2. Organize antiwaterlogging efforts in a comprehensive and effective manner; and strive to cultivate the 10th-month rice crop with all-out efforts in the spirit of the 24 July 1980 official message No 3,126-D2 of the premier with special attention given to protecting seedlings and immediately sowing reserve seed.
