MISSION OF SOVIET-VIETNAMESE SPACEFLIGHT ENDS

[Text] Attention, comrades! Here is a TASS statement: The flight of the international crew has been successfully concluded. Cosmonauts Viktor Gorbatko and Pham Tuan have returned to earth.

At 1815 on 31 July, 1980, after the successful completion of the planned program of joint work on board the Salyut-6--Boyuz-36--Boyuz-37 orbiting scientific-research complex, the international crew composed of pilot-cosmonaut of the USSR, Gorbatko, Viktor Vasilyevich, twice here of the Soviet Union, and the research-cesmonaut Pham Tuan, here of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam, returned to earth.

The cosmonauts, Comrades Popv and Ryumin are continuing their work on board the Salyut-6 station.

The descent module of the Soyuz-36 spaceship landed in the set area of the Soviet Union, 180 kilometers southeast of the town of Dzhbezkazgan. Comrades Gorbatko and Pham Tuan are well after their landing.

During the joint flight aboard the Salyut-6--Soyuz-36--Soyuz-37 erbiting complex, Comrades Popov, Ryumin, Gorbatko and Fhan Tuan carried out a number of technological and medico-biological research activities, and experiments prepared by specialist of the Soviet Union and Vietnam, and in which scientists from other socialist countries were also involved.

Under the program to study natural resources and the environment, the international crew made visual observations and took photographs of the earth's surface, including specific regions of Vietnam.

The cosmonauts also continued the experiments begun during previous flights by international crews, using scientific apparatus devised by specialists from the participant-countries of the Intercosmos program.

The fulfillment of a wide-ranging program of research on the Salyut-6-Soyuz orbiting complex has made it possible to gain fresh data which will be used in the interests of the national economy and the further development of space science and technology.

The successfully completed space flight is convincing testimony to the further development of scientific and technical ties between the Soviet Union and Socialist Vietnam, and is another vivid example of the fruitful cooperation of scientists from the socialist countries in the peaceful conquest and utilization of space.
