

WILL SHOOT ROCKET SOON.

German Professor to Attempt Projection Into the Stratosphere.

BERLIN, Nov. 22.—Professor Hermann Oberth now hopes to have his "distance rocket" ready for projection into the stratosphere within a week or ten days. He has not yet decided where the experiment will be made, but is confined in his choice to two or three isolated spots along the Pomeranian coast.

Professor Oberth has been conducting miniature experiments in the neighborhood of Berlin with trial rockets to which parachutes are attached. He also has perfected his liquid fuel to the point where he is convinced it is non-explosive, although he has announced that only a restricted number of spectators will be allowed to be present when he touches off his giant rocket in the direction of the moon.
