Chapter 19

Soviet Space Designers

When They Were Secrets*

Christian Lardier[†]

In the Soviet Union, from 1957 to 1991, the conquest of space was a complete state secret, because it was under the control of the defense industry, in other words the military-industrial complex. What the Western world knew about the Soviet Union space program was the official version through TASS press releases published in *Pravda* (The Truth). Meanwhile, the Americans spread another version, unofficial, which was intended to clarify the many mysteries behind the Soviet Union's space program. The lack of information was an open door to disinformation.

For example, after the launch of Sputnik-1, questions were raised concerning the paternity of the satellite project. For many years, the father of Sputnik was called Leonid Sedov.¹ Then, a mysterious "chief engineer" appeared during the first manned flights in 1961. His name, Sergei Korolev, would be revealed only at his death on 14 January 1966. This marked the beginning of active research into the identity of the chief designers of the Soviet space program. Researchers had to rely on necrologies signed by important people (under their real name), and histories such as those by the engineer Alexei Ivanov² and the journalist Alexander Romanov³ who used pseudonyms to hide the identity of designers, plus reports issued during Communist Party congresses (every five years) and elections for the Academy of Science (every two years). Among the people identified in this way were the ministers in charge of Space activities,

the "Space Theoretician" Mtislav Keldysh, and the six main designers of rockets and satellites, as well as numerous directors of institutes (NII) and design offices (OKB).

The names of some designers who had been identified, broke out in western publications. Charles Vick (USA) was listing 19 names in 1974: M. V. Keldysh, S. P. Korolev, L. A. Voskressensky, K. D. Bouchouyev, B. V. Raouchenbakh, K. P. Feoktistov, V. P. Glouchko, N. A. Piliougine, M. K. Yangel, V. N. Tchelomei, V. P. Makeiev, A. M. Isaiev, G. N. Babakine, G. I. Voronine, V. V. Parine, A. Trefimur(?), L. Yaglom ?), and N. Stern(?).

In 1974, Claude Wachtel (France) mentioned the names of S. P. Korolev, V. P. Glouchko, M. P. Vassiliev (Michine) and B. E. Evseiev (Tchertok) in volume 11 of *Cosmos Encyclopedia*. In 1977, in "Le livre d'or de la Science," Christian Lardier (France) quoted the names of V. F. Outkine, M. F. Rechetnev, V. P. Makeiev, I. M. Andronov (Iossifian), V. P. Michine and K. D. Bouchouyev. At that time, the TsSKB activities had been attributed to Makeiev while he was heading the Tcheliabinsk KBM.

Then, in 1985, in the *Journal of the BIS*, Claude Wachtel published an article on the main designers. He was later quoted by M. F. Rechetnev himself in the first "open" article, which came out in the *Pravda* dated November 13, 1989. He gave a comprehensive list of 43 names: S. P. Korolev, V. P. Glouchko, N. A. Piliougine, V. P. Barmine, V. I. Kouznetsov, M. S. Riazansky, V. P. Michine, K. D. Bouchouyev, You. P. Semenov, B. E. Tchertok, S. O. Okhapkine, A. You. Ichlinsky, B. V. Raouchenbakh, S. M. Alexeiev, G. I. Voronine, N. A. Lobanov, N. S. Stroiev, V. G. Sergueiev, M. K. Yangel, V. N. Tchelomei, G. N. Babakine, A. G. Iossifian, M. F. Rechetnev, D. I. Kozlov, A. M. Isaiev, S. A. Kosberg, A. D. Konopatov, V. F. Outkine, V. S. Boudnik, V. M. Kovtounenko, P. I. Nikitine, V. P. Makeiev, A. D. Nadiradze, P. D. Grouchine, B. P. Joukov, K. N. Roudnev, L. V. Smirnov, S. A. Afanaseiev, G. A. Tiouline, B. V. Balmont, V. Ya. Litvinov, O. D. Baklanov, and You. A. Mozjorine.

However, an inaccuracy can be found in this article regarding the Salyut orbital station program. Indeed, he wrongly attributes this program to Tchelomei, while the latter was only responsible for Almaz military stations. Finally, a fairly comprehensive list was published by Asif Siddiqi in the magazine *Spaceflight* in August and September 1994.

The first clues on the designers' identity could be found in the memoirs of Oleg Penkovsky⁴ published in 1965. They mentioned the trials made on the missiles R-12, R-14 and R-16 which were built in Dniepropetrovsk and related the October 24, 1960, accident which cost Marshal M. I. Nedene's life. Moreover, it referred to the rockets made by the constructor V. N. Tchelomei who had two laboratories at his disposal in Moscow and whose assistant was N. S. Khrushchev's son.

The book *The Russian Space Bluff*, written by Leonid Vladimirov⁵ and published in 1971, mentioned for the first time the competition existing between Korolev and Tchelomei. It had, however, quite a few inaccuracies. For example, it said that Tchelomei was at the head of the NII-88 in 1946 where Korolev supervised the rocket department and that he remained later on a more powerful level than Korolev up to 1958, when a decree compelled him to help Korolev in the development of Vostok. The book narrated that Korolev had given up the moon project in response to Apollo because, had this project been realized, it would have been attributed to Tchelomei. But after Khrushchev was dismissed, in 1965, he suggested to Brezhnev a new program, which included the lunar landing. Actually, Tchelomei was competing with Beria's son and the plane manufacturer Mikoyan in the field of cruise missiles from 1944 to 1959. He only became Korolev's rival after 1960, when Khrushchev decided to transfer part of aeronautical industry towards space industry (OKB of Tchelomei, Miassichtchev, Lavotchkine, Kouznetsov, Lioulka, Toumansky, etc). However, Tchelomei's influence ceased by 1964, with Brezhnev coming to power. Vladimirov quoted for the first time the name of life support system designer G. I. Voronine.

In the *Soviet Encyclopedia of World Astronautics*, published under the direction of V. P. Glouchko in 1971, a few names attributed to places on the dark side of the moon are former colleagues of Glouchko (G. S. Giritsky, A. I. Gavrilov, A. D. Gratchev, N. P. Alekhine, N. N. Artamonov, You. B. Mezentsev), designers L. A. Voskressensky (1913-1965), S. A. Kosberg (1903-1965) and A. A. Raspletine (1908-1967), or M. I. Nedeline (1902-1960), B. M. Konoplev (1912-1960) and G. F. Firsov (1917-1960) who died during the October 24, 1960 accident (the explosion of the first R-16 in Baikonour).

Khrushchev's memoirs published in 1974 brought a number of additional details on the role of few designers. According to him, Korolev had been involved in the "Bouria" missile of Lavotchkine and had created the "Semoirka" with the help of those who built the engine and the launch platform Barmine, whereas Yangel had created the missiles with a storable propellant (R-12, R-14). Coastal defense missiles were attributed to V. N. Tchelomei and A. I. Mikoyan (altered MiG-15). The anti-aircraft missiles were built by two persons, one working with Beria's son on the SA-1 and 2, and the other one on the SA-3 mobile system. An anecdotal detail on Tchelomei was quoted: he had imagined a kind of V-1 with spreadable wings launched from a container, but when the idea was suggested to Stalin, Tchelomei was dismissed and the works were handed over to Mikoyan whose brother was the vice-president of the Ministry Council.

Pseudonyms

The Russians used pseudonyms to preserve the designers' anonymity. Alexei Ivanov's book published in 1975 (2nd edition) gave a list of personalities, among whom some were hidden under pseudonyms. The list included S. P. Korolev, Roman Anissimovitch (Tourkov), L. A. Voskressensky, Boris Evseievitch (Tchertok), Konstantin Dmitrievitch (Bouchouyev), Mikhail Stepanovitch (Khomakov), Alexei Ivanov (Ivanovsky), Arkadi Ilitch (Ostachev), A. V. Pallo, Semen Mikhailovitch (Alexeiev), Fedor Anatolievitch (Vostokov), Vassili Fedorovitch (Bogomolov), Piotr Fedorovitch (Bratslavetz), etc.

A. P. Romanov's book on Korolev, published in 1976 (4th edition) provided the following names: K. N. Roudnev, M. V. Keldysh, S. P. Korolev, V. P. Glouchko, N. A. Piliougine, Vadim Semenov (S. M. Alexeiev), L. A. Voskressensky, Professor Vassiliev (V. P. Michine), Konstantin Davydov (K. D. Bouchouyev), Alexei Ivanov (O. G. Ivanovsky), Evgueny Alexandrovitch (E. A. Frolov), Konstantin Feoktistov, Alexandre Mrykine, Georgui Alexandrovitch (Tiouline), Anatoli Semenovitch (Kirillov), etc. Romanov had disclosed the name of Piliougine in an article of *Socialist Industry* dated December 29, 1974.

In 1977, volume 24 of the *Great Soviet Encyclopedia* gave the names of Keldysh, Korolev, Yangel, Tchelomei, Glouchko, Piliougine, Barmine, Babakine, Isaiev, Kosberg, Ichlinsky, B. N. Petrov, G. I. Petrov, etc. In the 1981 edition, the names of K. D. Bouchouyev, A. G. Iossifian, V. I. Kouznetsov, M. S. Riazansky and V. A. Kotelnikov were added.

Obituaries

The designers' identities were only revealed at the moment of their death, when an obituary would be published in daily newspapers. The latter was signed by most of the designer leaders and colleagues, thus granting it a very special importance.

The main obituaries were those of S. P. Korolev in 1966, M. K. Yangel, A. M. Isaiev and G. N. Babakine in 1971, M. V. Keldysh and K. D. Bouchouyev in 1978, N. A. Piliougine in 1982, V. N. Tchelomei in 1984, V. P. Makeiev in 1985, A. D. Nadiradze in 1987, M. S. Riazansky in 1987, V. P. Glouchko in 1989, V. I. Kouznetsov in 1991, and V. P. Barmine in 1993.

The Science Academy of the Soviet Union

This academy led the civil space program. Its president M. V. Keldysh was the "theorist of cosmonautics" and he also presided over the Scientific Committee for Space Research in 1961-1975. He was replaced by the atomist

A. P. Alexandrov from 1975-1986, by G. I. Martchouk from 1986-1991 and then, by You. S. Ossipov starting in 1991. The Intercosmos Council for space cooperation was directed by B. N. Petrov from 1966-1982, then by V. A. Kotelnikov from 1982-1991. Every other year, elections of active or correspondent members were organized. The list of candidates was published in an issue of *Izvestia* and in the magazine *Vestnik AN SSSR*. In the departments of physics and astronomy or mechanics and guidance process, a large number of space industry designers could be found in the lists, with some of them being elected after one, two or three attempts. Usually those designers were doctors of the technical sciences, but rarely a professor. In a book published in 1979 on the Ukrainian Academy of Sciences, one could find biographies of M. K. Yangel, V. S. Boudnik, V. F. Outkine, V. M. Kovtounenko, I. I. Ivanov, N. F. Guerassiouta (OKB-586 of Dniepropetrovsk) as well as V. G. Sergueiev (OKB-692 of Kharkov). With the elections of 1982 and 1987, the names of V. F. Prisniakov and P. I. Nikitine were added to this list.

The Soviet Communist Party

Most designers were members of the Soviet Communist Party and representatives at national congresses. Some of them were even helped in their career thanks to their membership in the Soviet Communist Party (Yangel, Kozlov, Makeiev, etc.). Others would rest on family support to develop their influence (Mikoyan with Beria's son, Tchelomei with Khrushchev's son, etc.).

There were lobbies at government level. Indeed, the ministry of defense industries protected Korolev, while the ministry of aviation industry supported Tchelomei. The defense ministry switched over from supporting Tchelomei, when it was headed by A. A. Gretschko, to supporting Glouchko when D. F. Oustinov came to power.

Decorations

In the *Great Soviet Encyclopedia* in 30 volumes published between 1973 and 1978, the biographies of members from the Science academy could be found with their decorations: the Heroes of Socialist Work (HTS), the Lenin Prize (PL), and the State Prize (PE). These prizes had been awarded since 1939 (HTS), 1957 (PL) and 1967 (PE). The latter was called the Stalin Prize until 1953. Only nine atomists and two airplane constructors⁶ have been honored. Khrushchev and Keldysh were heroes three times, while on the other hand, one hundred persons were heroes twice.

Conclusion

The designers' names were so secretly kept that none of them could acquire fame on the international stage. Thus, when the idea of awarding the Nobel Prize to the creator of Sputnik-1 arose, Nikita Khrushchev refused it because he did not want to unveil the identity of Korolev. Of course, the latter was a member of Nomenklatura and did receive all national honors, but he remained unknown outside the USSR. Many other constructors as important as Korolev still remain little known or totally unknown in Western countries. We must change this situation if we want them to have the honors they deserve.

Reference Notes

- ¹L.I. Sedov (1907) was president of the astronomy council space commission (AN SSSR) in 1954-1962 and president of the IAF from 1961-1963. A. A. Blagonravov (1894-1975) was president of the state commission for geophysical rockets, vice-president of COSPAR in 1959, then president of the space study commission of AN SSSR in 1963. Both of them were public interfaces since the space program was actually in the hands of Keldysh's commission. Sedov's secretary was A. G. Karpenko, Blagonravov's secretary was M. G. Krochkin (1923-1974), Keldysh's secretary was G. A. Skouridine (1927-1991), then M. Ya. Marov.
- ²O. G. Ivanovsky (1922) entered the Korolev OKB in 1946 where he was assistant chief designer of Sputnik-1, then chief designer of Luna, Vostok, Zenith, Elektron and Molnya from 1958-1961, head of a department in the VPK from 1961-1965, main designer of the OKB-301 for the Luna from 1965-1971, then main designer of the NPO Lavotchkine for the Luna from 1971-1983. He was the author of "Pervye Stoupeni" in 1970, 1975, 1982.
- ³A. P. Romanov was one of the official biographers of S. P. Korolev with Olga Apentchenko (1969), P. T. Astachenkov (1969, 1973, 1975), Ya. K. Golovanov (1973, 1994), You. V. Birioukov (1980), and G. S. Vetrov (1988, 1994). His books on Korolev were published in 1969, 1971, 1972, 1976, 1981, and 1990.
- ⁴O. V. Penkovsky was a close friend of the artillery marshal S. S. Varentsov. He had stayed in Great Britain and France from 1960-1962. After the Cuban Missile Crisis, he had given information on Russian rockets to Americans. He was executed for high treason on May 16, 1963.
- ⁵Leonid Vladimirov was a journalist for the magazine *Znanie Sila* before becoming a refugee in the United States.
- ⁶The two are S. A. Lavotchkine and P. D. Grouchine whose OKB-301 and OKB-2 are in Khimki near Moscow. The OKB of Lavotchkine built the SA-1 missile from 1951-1960, then was a subsidiary of Tchelomei from 1960-1964 before becoming the OKB of interplanetary space probes directed by G. N. Babakine in March 1965. Grouchine, who was a collaborator of Lavotchkine from 1951-1953, will deal with the OKB-293 of M. R. Bisnovat to make the SA-2 and SA-3 missiles. The OKB of Grouchine became the leader in producing the SAM ground-to-air missiles.
